Vacuum Services — Clean Harbors' specialized vacuum services collect and transport wet or dry hazardous and non-hazardous materials. Vacuum equipment including stainless steel, carbon steel, dry and liquid units is selected based on the nature and quantity of the material to be removed. We provide vacuum services on a routine or an emergency basis for general plant maintenance and planned projects as well as for emergency spills or product release situations.

Tank Cleaning — Clean Harbors can successfully clean your most difficult tanks. Serving numerous industries, municipalities and utility companies, we are equipped to handle a broad spectrum of cleaning from 10-gallon acid neutralization tanks for medical and biotechnology companies to six million-gallon, 240-foot diameter refinery tanks.

Decontamination — Clean Harbors offers decontamination services for a wide range of circumstances by removing, neutralizing, or destroying any harmful substance. Utilizing various methods, we decontaminate small machinery, fume hoods, clean-rooms, buildings, entire facilities and any other contaminated areas.

Emergency Response — Throughout North America, we manage environmental emergency responses or disaster recovery operations on land and water. From a cleanup and removal of a single mercury bottle, a large-scale multiphase containment and cleanup of a coastal oil spill, to damage from a hurricane, customers trust our expertise and technical

Product Recovery & Transfer — Clean Harbors provides immediate and complete capture of spilled product, which is the optimal way to minimize the overall cost of spill site remediation. Transfer services are also performed on a non-emergency basis when customers need to move materials from tank to tank or over water.

Demolition & Dismantling — We provide demolition and dismantling services in emergency and scheduled situations. Applications may include demolition and dismantling of partial or total building or plant structures. From the removal of process equipment, tanks and piping, to removing reinforced concrete, structural steel, wall and flooring, or the demolition of contaminated buildings and structures, our experts can rapidly produce a comprehensive plan to safely address a dangerous situation.

Scarifying & Media-Blasting — We remove staining or nearsurface contamination from porous and non-porous surfaces. Our processes can also be used to prepare surfaces such as concrete, for sealing with chemical resistant sealers in process floor space, and for secondary tank containments. By removing only the contaminated portions of surfaces, unnecessary demolition, reconstruction, transportation and disposal expenses are avoided.

Benefit from Our Full Range of Services

Steam Cleaning — Our steam cleaning services remove all types of stains from concrete, oil from surfaces, and residues from process equipment utilizing steam pressure washers ranging from 600 to 4,000 psi at 13-15 gpm, and temperatures ranging from ambient to 200 degrees. To maximize cleaning effectiveness, we add specialty chemicals, detergents, degreasers, mild acids and bases as needed. Compared to traditional hydro-wash techniques, the volume of waste generated from steam cleaning is reduced, which may result in lower overall project costs.

Excavation & Removal — Clean Harbors provides excavation and removal services for soil remediation projects, new construction, and expansion and real estate transactions. This fundamental, frontline remediation method involves the removal of contaminated soil and media, which are typically shipped off-site for treatment and/ or disposal. It is also used for the removal and abandonment of underground structures that are out of compliance or have been identified as a potential or actual point source of contamination.

Facility Closures — When a facility closes or needs to be relocated, we can package, transport and dispose of chemicals from inventory, waste by- products from operations, maintenance products, and chemical samples. We tailor our cleanout and removal services to each site's requirements. Our experience ranges from small, one-day closures within the same building to larger, multiple-lab closures and building decontaminations.

Rail Car Cleaning & Inspection — Clean Harbors provides a full range of rail car cleaning and inspection services at customer sites, other locations, or at one of our waste management facilities. We

are equipped to handle hazardous and non-hazardous products from tanker cars, intermodal and ISO containers, tote containers, and dry bulk cars.

Marine Booming & Line Handling — Clean Harbors services ports throughout the U.S., Canada and Puerto Rico. Our certified vessel operators and crews are trained and certified Persons in Charge (PIC) for transfer operations and can handle average most probable discharge (AMPD) coverage for lightering operations. We provide line handling on the waterfront to shipping agents, port facilities, oil terminals, and vessel owners, and either tie off or let go the lines from the vessel at the dock.

Maritime Services — We provide on board services including oil, chemical, gray water, septic, potable water, and ballast tank, bilge, void cleaning and inspection to meet ABS standards. Our emergency response and response readiness services handle spills on water and land. Under the U.S. Coast Guard's OSRO Classification Program, Clean Harbors holds Captain of the Port ratings for Facilities and Vessels in ports throughout the U.S. and Puerto Rico. We also provide hazardous and non-hazardous waste disposal and recycling, vessel decommissioning and abatement, and off- shore facility services.
